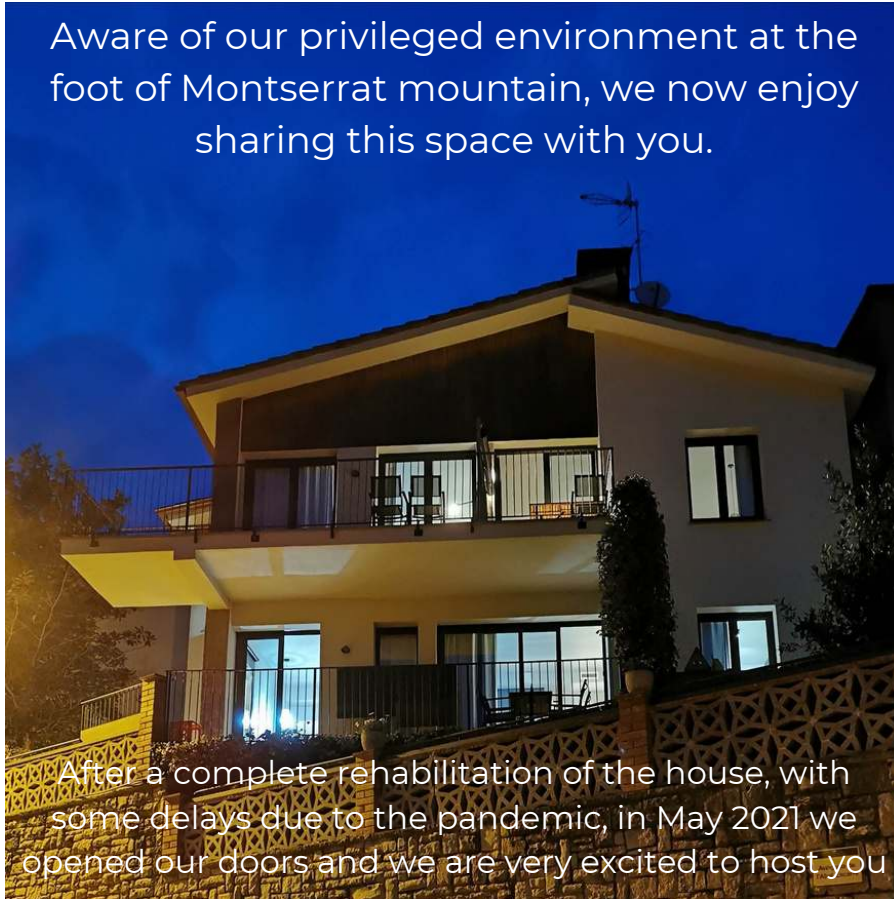

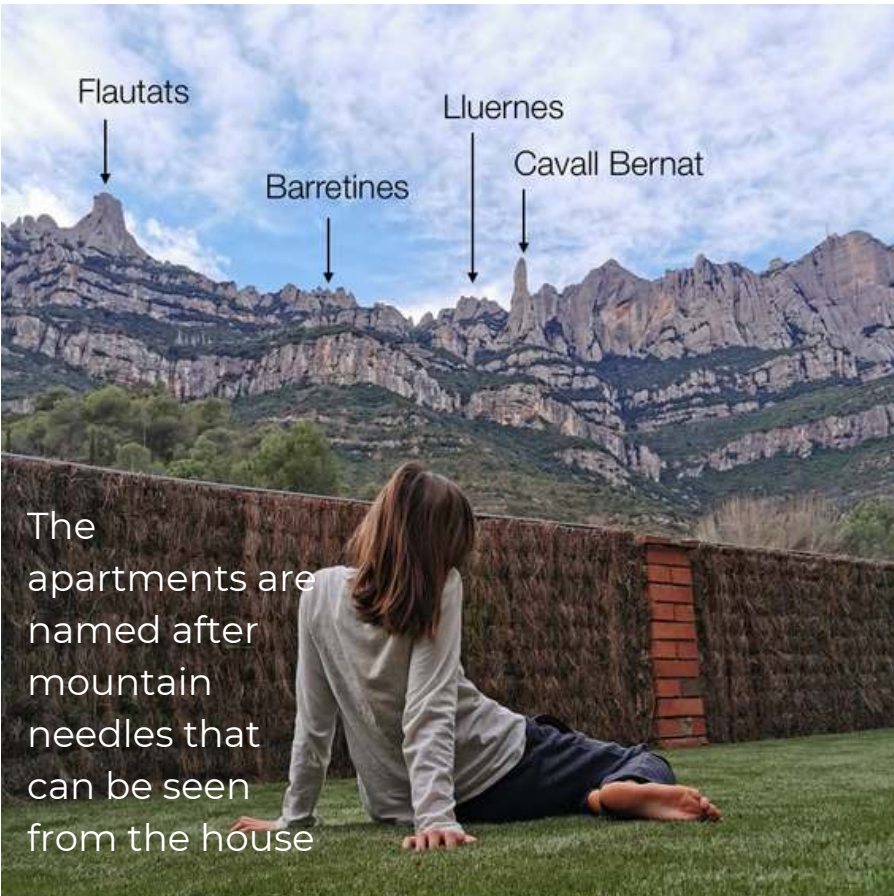

HOUSE RULES

THE KITCHEN

The kitchen is equipped with basic utensils for cooking and eating. Pots, pans, plates, glasses, large cups and cups of coffee, wine glasses, cutlery, knives, bottle, can opener, scissors, tweezers ... There is also a toaster, a microwave, a kettle, a juicer to make orange juice, a minipimer, a Dolce Gusto coffee maker and an italian coffee maker. Vitroceramic is induction. We'll leave you some oil, salt and sugar. With these photos you will have an idea of what you will find:



CLEANING UP

In the kitchen we leave a scrubber, a napkin and dish soap. In the closet of the room you will find basic cleaning utensils (broom, shovel, mop) in case you need to clean something during your stay.

As you leave we will thank you for leaving the dishes and utensils you used clean and stored. We will take care of removing the sheets, towels and cleaning the apartment thoroughly once you leave.

Below the sink you will find a dish drainer.

RECYCLING

Next to the coffee maker you will find a container to leave used coffee capsules. You can leave them there and we will take care of recycling them.

You have paper, plastic, glass and organic recycling bins very close to the apartment. Exit on the left and at the end of the descent



VISIT THE MONASTERY OF MONTSERRAT

A UNIQUE PLACE, FULL OF SPIRITUALITY, CULTURE AND NATURE!

Agulles de Montserrat is an ideal accommodation to visit the monastery.

Once in Montserrat you can spend a full day visiting the abbey, listening to the choir of Montserrat, visiting the museum, hiking around the area, going up the funiculars or going to the holy cave. We explain how to get there.



By car

Take the road that takes you directly from Monistrol to the Monastery (8,7 kms). There you have to park your car in the parking of the monastery, it costs 6,5 Euros per day.

Manresa

Manresa is the capital of Bages. The city is about 20 minutes away from the apartments. It offers its medieval streets and modernist squares as a historical proof that the city has had since its beginnings.



Monastery Sant Benet del Bages

This Benedictine monastery is one of the best preserved monastic complexes of the Middle Ages in Catalonia. It is located 22 kms from the apartments.



Rocafort and Mura

They are two villages located approximately 30 minutes away from the apartments. They are in an emblematic location with charm and pride in their appearance from a bygone era.

Montserrat Caves

We find it located in Collbató, and it is the only one that allows a subway passage of 400 meters long enjoying tourist conditioning.

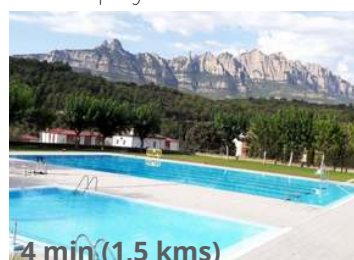

Pla de Bages is a privileged area, one of the peculiarities are the vats and the wine barrels to keep the agricultural tools or to protect from the inclemency of the weather. Due to the importance of the wine in the whole region, we leave you some suggestions to understand the process of the wine and to visit the different vineyards.



WINERY FARGAS - FARGAS

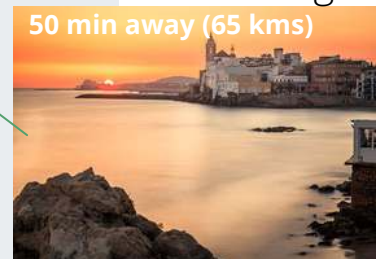
